General hostility, loss of supporters (14:50)

No miracles except the Withered Fig Tree (11)

High Priest: “Are you the Christ,

the **Son** of the Blessed?” (14:61-62)

Transition (15:22)

A' At Golgotha and the Tomb (15:23-16:8)

Tempting of Jesus on the cross (15:29-32)

Elijah (15:35-36)

Curtain of the Temple torn (σχιζω) in two (15:38)

“Truly this man was the **Son of God!**” (15:39)

Young Man **refers to Jesus** (16:1-8), **Clothed in linen** (16:5)

“He is going before you..” (16:7)
